During March we had a 10 day preacher training on the ranch with preachers and potential preachers these are all men who help me in my area I am excited about the spiritual growth they are showing, and the work they are doing.

ZIMABWE

The political situation in Zimbabwe continues to deteriorate there are terrible reports coming out of Zimbabwe of the human right abuses by the Government, Mugabe has spies in every walk of life and we as preachers going into Zimbabwe have to be very careful.

I continue my visits with the churches preaching and teaching, it is always an encouragement to see the brethren's faith under difficult conditions, the Churches are growing we continue to see added to the Lord.

The drought situation: the southern parts of Zimbabwe know as Matabeleland in which I work has had no rain and therefore no crops its going to be a very difficult year for the brethren, maize meal is still in short supply and last week

The Government raised the price for Maize meal by 650%; the majority of brethren don't have any sort of income because of the Zimbabwe economy, which adds to their hardships. I still have funds till the end of June, I will then be

Making an appeal for help for the brethren, but as always please pray for these brethren, who survive because of your Love for the Lord.

SOUTH AFRICA

Little Falls, and Mpofu Church, the work there continues to go well. Mpofu Church now has an older brother Joseph with his family from Vendaland who are worshipping and helping with the work at Mpofu I am still not able to go into

Crook's corner as I still have no interpreter for this area I do not speak this Language brother Joseph said he would speak to some young men who might be willing to help with this, but it will come about in the Lords time.

Brethren You are all part of the work I do and many are part of the benevolence for the brethren, without you this work would not be possible, Lyn and I are thankful for your love of the Lord and to us and continue to remember you in our prayers and in our thoughts.
