Dear brethren , the winter still continues to be cold and as June and July are our mid winter months we are fealing it now.,especialy our brethren out in the villages and bush.The children and I are still all together and dealing with all the new routine and changes in our lives , still no futher developements in my divorce case ,I am just bracing myself each day for what happens next .It does however look like it will only be settled in court so please continue to prayer for us .On a lighter note we are all fit and healthy and I am still busy in the Lords vineyard and I hope that this e-mail finds you all well.

### ZIMBABWE WORK.

The work in Zimbabwe is doing well , my trips into Zimbabwe have become a litle more tense as there seems to be an undercurrent moving around politics again ,as people become more desperate about the countries economy and price increases .The young preachers will keep me posted on the situation so that I do not land up in the middle of a conflict on one of my trips.

The very exciting news is that we started a new work at a village called Sadzangwena which is on my route to the other churches I work with .We baptized 8 people and have brother Lyston help with the preaching and leading from Ngundu Church which is not to far away.The other congregations are all doing well ,I visited all 6 congregations on my last trip and did alot of teaching and encouraging ,the brehren are all doing well and ask for prayers for rain as the next planting season approches.The rain was not good last year as you may remember and the brethren did manage to raise a small

crop , this food is however now finished and there is need once again to help these brethren for the next 3 months with basic corn meal at at least 4 of these congregations.

#### BOTSWANA WORK.

This month into Botswana was a great trip for me ,as my trip was planned for the same time as my children had thier school vacation so they all came along with me .I also had a young man brother Brady from the USA come along on the trip ,so we had a full car and it was a nice change from driving alone .I gave brother Brady the oppertunity to teach and preach while he was with us and he did a fine job and we all really enjoyed having Brady along .The work in Botswana still continues to be a hard, as we still do not have any really faithfull men to help lead in these works .The teaching and learning process is slow but I can see that brethren are growing and thier knowlege does increase .The Tswana tribe is a very shy nation ,so they are not very vocal nor do they ask many questions as I would like .This said the Mabua Church and the Moijabana Church are the only 2 true Churches in Botswana , so this does keep me motivated as I have come along way from having no true Churches in Botswana.

#### SOUTH AFRICA WORK.

The Mabalabala work is consistant and with faithfull men ,with hands on it does make a big difference to the work and faithfulness of the brethren. As the hunting season comes to an end our members who have had to work over some of the Sundays will all be back and we will all be able to finish our fencing around the building .We still have 2 to 3 visistors attending and we are teaching them and pray they will obey the truth .With the school vacation we did have a few extra children coming which was encouraging for my children .

That brings me to the end of my report for this month , thankyou once again for all your prayers and love and support , I will tarry on in the work here in Africa .
