We had over 200 people that day and two more ladies were baptized .The next couple of days we traveled on and visited and preached at Mukukusi Church , Mutupurwa Church, Conjange Church and Machona Church all the lessons and the preachers were received well .There is still no food available and water and electricity are few and far between in the cities .The brethern need our prayers for rain and stability .Each congregation handed a number of thankyou letters to Clarence and others for the drought and food aid monies that they have received .

BOTSWANA.

We also made a trip into Botswana together ,it is so good to have company on the trips and encouraging for me and the brethren in these villages, both in Botswana and Zimbabwe To hear the same gospel preached and see that brethren are willing to come out all the way from the USA to their humble villages to teach and encourage .We taught both the children and the adults lessons at Mabua Church and Moijabana Church the days we spent in Botswana.We baptized another lady at Mabua church.The weather was not so good ,we had strong winds and rain all the days we were there ,the rain was welcomed but it is not easy trying to teach out in the open when you have bad weather.All in all it was a good trip and good company.

MABALABALA.

The brethren from the states gave mens training classes at Mabalabla Church , these lessons were all well presented and well received from

the men in the congregation .We have some good faithfull men in the congregation and this is a blessing for this work .Later on in the month we came back to Mabalabala and Max taught the bible study and I translated.Two men decided to be baptized that night and that was wonderfull for the church.
