

Africa work report October 2007

Dear Brethren .

I hope this e-mail finds you all healthy and well .The children and I are all well , another month has passed and the children are all getting ready to write exams as thier school year is comming to an end .I have made a loan to pay out Monica a settelment, this has bought me some time to sell things off to pay her in full ,but it has been a very expensive and straining time for me , with extra financial burdens to me ,but we are all healthy and fit and together ,we have a very buisy routine but coping well please keep us in your prayers. We still need prayers for rain as we did have a good start this season but not much follow up rain as yet.

ZIMBABWE.

My border crossing was fast this trip and not many road blocks, which takes alot of tenssion off. The brethren are all doing well ,still a huge food shortage and in general nothing is available in Zimbabwe .The Ngundu area did receive thier first rains but the Mukukusi area still have had no rain .We need to continue praying for rain as this will be thier saving grace .I am still taking in food relief funds to all the churches and will need to do this untill end of Febuary .If it does rain Lord willing thier corn could be harvested by Feb and last through the winter.We baptized 3 more woman at the new Sadzagwena congregation and the Dare congregation also had a new lady baptized .The Conjange congregation had good attendence from visitors on my visit and they showed alot of interest ,so there may be some potential in the future .The Mukukusi Church , Machona Church and Mutupurwa brethren are all doing well .

BOTSWANA.

The trip into Botswana was good ,the weather was also fair ,so it eaisier to teach in the open without the strong wind and the dust and sand blowing .The brethren at the Mabua Church are all well , and the mood is upbeat ,the young man who was visiting was not there on my last trip ,he does have potential and I hope this will develope into a man who can help lead in these congregations .The Mojaibane Church is also doing fine and we have 2 ladies visiting that seem quite interested .

MABALABALA .

The two new brothers that were baptized are doing well and are learing alot and are being encouraged by the congregation .Brother Shepherd is back from his vacation and its good to have him back.The rest of the brethren are all doing well.Nothing else to report on the work at Mabalabala just that we are all faithfull and doing well.
