Watertown Wanderings

July 30, 2007

Dear Brethren,

We send fond greetings from Northern New York. Believe it or not, the "dog days of summer" are upon us. Of course, in the North Country this means temperatures in the mid to high 80's.

I preached at Tri-County every Sunday in July. Sermon topics were "Individual Benevolent Responsibilities" (July 1), "Congregational Benevolent Responsibilities" (July 8), "What Is Man?" (July 15), "Heaven" - Part 1 (July 22), and "Heaven" - Part 2 (July 29).

During July our average attendance was 18 for Sunday morning class, 35 for the Sunday worship assembly, and 10 for Wednesday evening. Our total contribution for the month was \$2700.02.

David, Debbie, and Lance Christopher are moving to Alabama tomorrow. Only Debbie was a member, but she has been a member at Tri-County for nine of the twelve years we have existed.

During July I spoke to the Florida College Camp in New Jersey on the work of the Lord in Uganda (July 5th), preached three times at the High School Church of Christ Lectures in Indianapolis July 10th and 11th ("All Have Sinned" - Romans 1-3,7, "Have We Forgotten There Is a Hell," and "Into All the World - Uganda, Nigeria"), and reported on my trip to Uganda to the congregation in Kokomo, Indiana (July 11th). We also visited with loved ones in Elgin, Illinois July 24th - 27th. Our son Bryan was on leave from military duty in Kuwait.

John Bosworth taught the Wednesday night class on Psalms while I was traveling. The Sunday morning class is on Second Corinthians.

When home we had Bible studies with Carolyn Brown in Lowville on Monday night and with Elias and Melissa Martinez in Watertown Thursday night.

Sandy sent out 24 copies of lesson one of the Bible correspondence course and graded and returned 28 lessons. I sent "Meditate on These Things" via e-mail to 931 addresses. We placed four new articles on our web site, christistheway.com. I continue to edit the weekly bulletins for the Tri-County Church of Christ and the Eastside Church of Christ. The TV programs Scott Futrell and I have taped air on two public access venues in Northern New York.

Our support presently is \$223 below our budget. Tri-County has increased its support to us by \$500. Two families have moved away, and we will lose more, but the congregation will maintain this level of support as long as possible. Burns Park will have to cease their support after September because their treasury is being depleted.

\$1500 of our monthly support is ear marked as work fund. My office is at home, we buy all our own office supplies, and we travel an average of ca. 1000 miles a week. The \$560 a month from the North Huntsville Church of Christ is for our medical insurance. We thank the Lord for you and your fellowship in our work.
